Alexandria Business Association Highlights Productive High-Level Meeting with the Governor of Alexandria



Alexandria Business Association (ABA), chaired by Mr. Mohamed Hanno, held an extensive meeting yesterday with Alexandria Governor Vice Admiral Ahmed Khaled Hassan Saeed to review ongoing development efforts, major challenges, and future plans aimed at restoring Alexandria's historic position and strengthening its economic role across multiple sectors.

ABA reaffirmed its full support for the Governor's efforts to elevate the city and reinforce its status as Egypt's second capital. During the meeting, Mr. Hanno commended the Governor for his commitment to strengthening institutional capacity and effectively managing the city's limited resources. He praised the Governor's data-driven approach to identifying problems and developing solutions, as well as his firm handling of urgent issues and his strong push toward digital transformation.

Governor Ahmed Khaled outlined a comprehensive plan to improve Alexandria's quality of life, including integrating the city into the Universal Health Insurance System by 2025, upgrading transport and traffic, and rehabilitating 659 roads with more expansion underway.

He highlighted advances in flood management, education, and housing, including reduced class density and improved conditions for polluted areas residents which helped earn Alexandria the 2025 Seoul Smart Cities Award.



During a wide-ranging discussion moderated by Mr. Mohamed Hanno, ABA members presented recommendations to enhance digital services, improve bridges and bus stations, and strengthen Alexandria's waste management system. The meeting concluded with a call for continued cooperation between the business community and local authorities to accelerate Alexandria's progress.

Alexandria Business Association & Senghor University Sign Cooperation Protocol for Professional Networking and Cadre Development



Alexandria business Association (ABA) has signed a cooperation protocol with Senghor University during the International Conference on Project Management in the African Context (CIMPCA), held in parallel with the inauguration of the university's new campus in hashtag#BorgElArab on Tuesday.

This partnership aligns with Senghor University's expansion strategy and its growing role in supporting development and strengthening human capacities across the African continent.

Mr. Mohamed Hanno, ABA Chairman, stated that the protocol aims to support Africa's development by preparing high-level leadership cadres in both the public and private sectors, while enhancing communication and collaboration within the Francophone community.

The agreement also includes organizing professional hashtag#networking events and job fairs to connect students with industry leaders and hashtag#business owners, in addition to facilitating exchange visits and hosting scientific seminars to explore collaboration opportunities and share expertise.

Mr. Hanno highlighted that ABA members will benefit from access to complementary training workshops offered through Senghor's programs, along with invitations to participate in the university's scientific forums and conferences.

During the visit, Senghor University arranged an introductory tour for ABA representatives' Alexandrian business leaders including Mr. Munir Shehfa, Chairman of the Export Committee, Dr. Hani elmenhawy, Mr. Basil Marco, and Ms. Marwa Abuheif, Director of External Relations.

The delegation explored the new campus and its advanced academic and hashtag#technical facilities, which open wider doors for future academic and professional collaboration.

The delegation emphasized the importance of identifying the most promising sectors for cooperation, with a strong focus on technology, entrepreneurship, chemical industries, and plastic automotive components.

ABA Chairman Mr. Mohamed Hanno stressed the value of strengthening cooperation with Singapore to support Egypt's economic transformation agenda.

He affirmed that Egypt represents a strategic trading hub that grants access to regional and global markets, especially with its advanced infrastructure and competitive investment climate.

Mr. Hanno also invited the delegation to explore the opportunities within the Suez Canal Economic Zone, given its potential for innovative and sustainable investments.


