Alexandria Business Association & Turkish Consul General Explore New Avenues for Trade Cooperation



Alexandria Business Association (ABA) H.E. Ms. Deniz Cankaya, Consul General of Türkiye in Alexandria, Alexandria, accompanied by Mr. Ahmet Alptekin Kılıç, Commercial Attaché, to discuss ways to strengthen bilateral cooperation and expand trade and partnership opportunities between Egypt and Türkiye.

The Turkish Consul General praised the Association's active role in supporting diverse economic sectors, highlighting its forward-looking vision in empowering women and youth. She also commended the Egyptian government's commitment to enhancing relations with Türkiye in a way that supports a positive business climate and boosts investment opportunities. Additionally, she noted the significant improvement in Egypt's investment climate across various sectors, including tourism, in light of the growing interest of Turkish tourists in Egyptian destinations.

For his part, Mr. Mohamed Hanno, ABA Chairman, emphasized the depth of economic relations between the two countries, pointing to the ongoing and effective communication between ABA and the Turkish Commercial Attaché, as well as the exchange of visits and joint meetings that contribute to strengthening trade relations.



Mr. Hanno also highlighted Alexandria's competitive advantages that have attracted a number of Turkish investors, including competitive labor costs and strong logistical capabilities. He further underlined the Association's role in coordinating with government entities most recently through engagement with the Egyptian Customs Authority to address challenges facing ABA members and propose practical solutions. Meanwhile, Eng. Medhat El-Kady, Vice Chairman of the Board, reviewed the investment opportunities available in Alexandria Governorate, calling for the organization of a broader meeting with Turkish investors to enhance cooperation and foster direct engagement with ABA members. He reaffirmed the competitiveness of the Egyptian market in terms of production costs.


